1. Is a champion supported by a dedicated team, in place and ready to drive the change?	
2. Is the purpose and direction of the change clearly articulated?

5. Have you communicated the logic behind the change clearly and concisely?	
6. Is there mutual trust and understanding?	
7. Are there communication mechanisms and a means to engage in open dialogue?	
8. Are people clear about their responsibilities for the change?	
9. Is the organization effectively organized to deliver the change?	
10. Do the plans envisage quick wins to help build consensus and maintain progress?	
11. How will those who lose or are damaged by the change be supported?	
12. How will you adapt to changes?
