<b>Is the business ready for the project?</b>	
<b>What is the strategy for handover of the project to the business?</b>	
<b>Scope definition</b>	
<b>Has the scope changed since Stage Two completion?</b>	
<b>What is the project progress against the Stage Two defined and prioritized project objectives?</b>	
<b>Project roadmap</b>	
<b>What project stages/stage gates have been completed? (For example project approved, design complete)</b>	
<b>Risk and issue management</b>	
<b>Have all project risks been reviewed regularly during project delivery?</b>	
<b>What is the status of mitigation plans?</b>	
<b>What is the status of contingency plans?</b>	
<b>What is the overall likelihood of achieving the project CSFs?</b>

<b>Project organization</b>	
<b>Are project activities being completed by the appropriate members of the organization?</b>	
<b>Contract and supplier management</b>	
<b>What external suppliers are being used?</b>	
<b>What is the external supplier status and performance?</b>	
<b>Project controls strategy</b>	
<b>Are project costs under control? (Review cost plan — for example actual versus budget)</b>	
<b>What is the likelihood that the project budget will be maintained (forecast to completion?)</b>	
<b>Is the project schedule under control? (For example review schedule and milestone progress)</b>	
<b>What is the likelihood that the project schedule will be achieved (forecast to completion?)</b>	
<b>Are there any changes to scope (quantity, quality and functionality)? Are the costs and schedule under control?</b>	
<b>Project review strategy</b>	
<b>Are regular Stage Three reviews being conducted? (Is performance being managed and monitored?)</b>	
<b>Is project performance adequate for project success?</b>	
<b>Is there regular reporting? (Is the Project Team adequately managing communication of progress and performance to all stakeholders?)</b>	
<b>Stage Three decision</b>	
<b>Is the project under control? (Is the project control strategy robust enough for project delivery to continue?)</b>	
<b>What is the certainty that the project will be successful?</b>	

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
